PROFESSIONAL CLASS 1 DRIVER

Classroom and hands-on skills training for this eight-week program is offered through the Women Building Futures Training Centre in Edmonton, where all COVID safety protocols are strictly followed.

Professional Class 1 Drivers operate gasoline and diesel powered trucks, tractor-trailers and similar vehicles to transport goods and materials over local routes or long distances.

This program takes students through the Alberta MELT driver training; combined with essential safety awareness and certification, Best Practices for Working in Transportation, and written and road testing for the Alberta MELT Class 1 licence.

Upon completion of this program, students will have job search support and earned employer referrals to support employment opportunities
