If you're interested in pursuing a career in construction but you're not sure which trade or where to start, this is the program for you!

Journeywoman Start (JWS) Lethbridge is a 12 week, tuition-free, hands-on training program that introduces students to a variety of different trades and provides introductory skills training in carpentry, welding, electrical, wind turbine technician, and heavy equipment technician.

The program will be a blend of in-person, virtual and online learning.
