Syncrude Heavy Equipment Operator

Heavy equipment operators drive and operate many different types of equipment including heavy hauler trucks, crawler dozers, graders, hydraulic and electric shovels, as well as other heavy equipment up to 400 tons.

The Syncrude Heavy Equipment Operator Program is a two-week classroom training program to prepare women to begin their careers as a heavy equipment operator. This is a competitive program, with 16 seats available, and tuition is covered by Syncrude for successful applicants. Classroom training consists of two weeks, a combination of in-person in Fort McMurray and virtual, followed by 364 days of paid hands-on training by Syncrude north of Fort McMurray.

Pre-Apprenticeship Heavy Equipment Technician

Heavy equipment technicians maintain, repair and overhaul heavy vehicles and industrial heavy equipment, and commercial transport devices connected to or moved by a power unit.

The Pre-Apprenticeship Heavy Equipment Technician program is a four-week training program designed to prepare women to begin their careers as a Heavy Equipment Technician (HET).

Classroom training consists of completion of required safety tickets, hands-on training at Keyano College and WBF best practices to prepare the student to begin employment. This competitive program has 12 seats available and will offer an opportunity for its students to engage in a ten-month employment placement to ensure the hours and experience for their 1st year of technical training as a heavy equipment technician.
