Power Engineer Career Accelerator is an introductory program of basic safety certifications and workplace readiness.

Upon completion of training with WBF, students will transition to Lakeland College for their 4th Class Power Engineering training. After becoming 4th Class Certified, the students will return to Lakeland College to complete their 3rd Class Power Engineering training.

*Lakeland College's accredited Power Engineer program is a two-year program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must meet Lakeland College's Power Engineer program requirements
- Successful completion of fitness screening (35lb lift/carry)
- Successful completion of drug & alcohol assessment
- Alberta Class 5 Drivers' License

Applicants will also need to complete a variety of steps as part of their application.

- Financial support may be available to support students in this program.


EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES
