We do not require a high school diploma for this program; however, applicants will take an assessment for basic math, science, and reading skills and will need to meet a minimum

Applicants will also need to complete a variety of steps as part of their application.

#### **PROGRAM COST**

- Tuition for this program is sponsored by the Government of Alberta
- Additional funding and awards may be available to support living expenses while in the program.

#### **EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

Upon completion, graduates will be interviewed with WBF Employment Partners for potential employment in an entry-level construction role.
